The holder of the registration letter is required to notify, in writing, the adjacent landowners as well as the local authority (municipality), of this decision within 14 days of receipt of this registration letter and the provisions to appeal the decision as stated below.

An appeal may be lodged by any member of the public against the issuing of this registration number in terms of Section 43 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 and the National Appeal Regulations, 2014, which sets out the appeal procedures.
